We are also honouring two President's counsel, a professor of engineering and, most importantly, the oldest living Commander of Sri Lanka Air Force.


All these gentlemen and lady have brought honour to the College in all their words and deeds".














CELEBRATING COLLAGE DAY WITH FAITH AND UNITY








A SPECTACULAR CELEBRATION OF MOTORSPORTS AND COMMUNITY SPIRIT



Dr.Thilak is a proud product of Maris Stella College, Negombo. We wish him all the very best in his new role as the chairman of CEB.




